Pupil Premium 2014-2015

The Pupil Premium is allocated to children from low-income families who are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (FSM), or have been eligible in the past six years, for children that have been looked after in the care of the Local Authority for more than six months and to children whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces. The funding is allocated to schools in both mainstream and non-mainstream settings.

The Pupil Premium children worked broadly in line with national Pupil Premium figures.
