Lemur Class had their third session of tag rugby with [#jasonrobinsonfoundation](#) today and were confident with their passing.



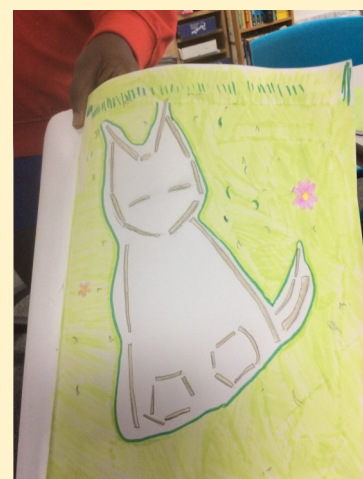
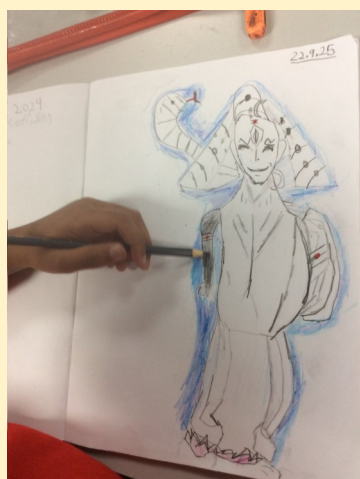

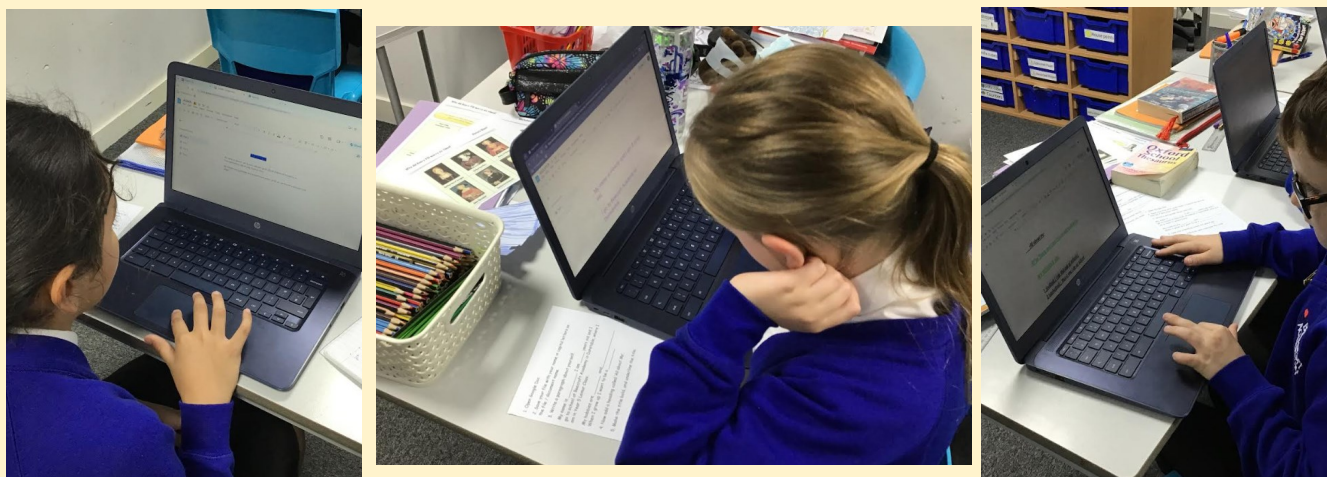
Fun in the sun at lunchtime last week!

Starting School 2026

Information for parents and carers of children applying for a Reception Year place

Children born between 01/09/21 and 31/08/22 are due to start school in September 2026. You need to make an application to us by 15 January 2026, even if your child attends a nursery/pre-school on the school site.

All the information you will need regarding your Starting School 2026 application is available on our website, or our 2026 booklet and we strongly advise that you read it before submitting your application

Making your application

Legislation requires you to apply through your home local authority. If you live outside of Central Bedfordshire, you must contact the local authority you live in and apply to them.

We recommend that you apply online as it is quick, simple and safe. However, you can alternatively make a paper application; the forms can be downloaded from our website.

Do not make both a paper and online application, if you do only your latest application (submitted before the closing date) will be processed and your first application will be discarded.

All applications received by the School Admissions Team after the national closing dates will be classed as late and not processed until the late allocation round. Late applications are not dealt with until after all the on-time applications have been considered.

Please Note:

Parents are requested to consider how a child would be transported to school, as transport entitlement is only considered if a student meets the qualifying criteria set by the School Transport team.

National Closing Date for Starting School 2026

15th January 2026

You must apply using your child's current primary address (where they live as of the national closing date).
