Every year at this time we come together as a community to read the names of the women & girls who have lost their lives to male violence, over the last year.

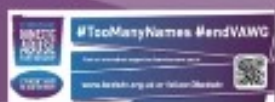
Help us shine a spotlight on the issue of violence towards women and girls.
