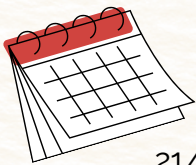

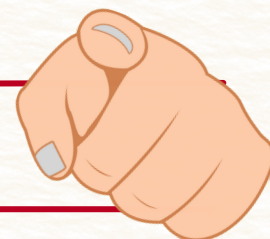

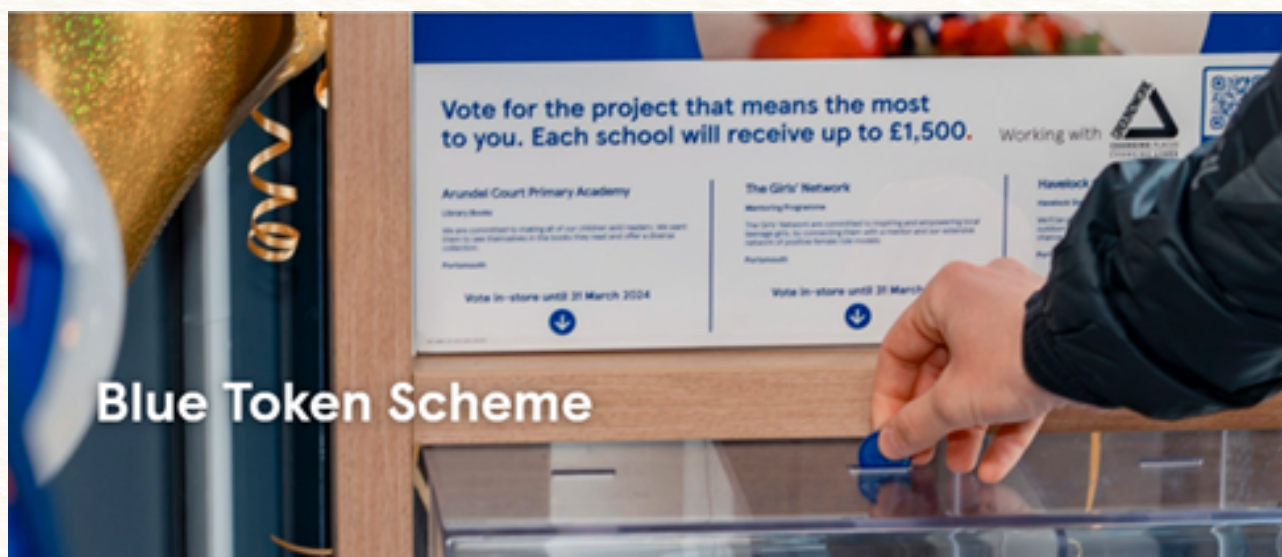
Please vote for us in the Tesco 'blue token' scheme!
