Autumn Interim Report - Standardised Assessments

Dear Parents/Carers

Your child's Autumn Term Interim Report will be shared via email across this week. Please find enclosed within your child's Interim Report the following:

For reading, writing and mathematics;

- current attainment grade for your child
- their targeted grade and progression towards this at the end of the academic year
- an attitude to learning grade

For foundation subjects;

- an attitude to learning grade
- current attainment grades

Your child will be assessed as either:

- **Below** – working below the age-related curriculum,
- **Working Towards** – working on the age-related curriculum but below the expected standard for this point in the academic year,
- **On-Track** - working at the age-related expected standard for this point in the academic year,
- **Greater Depth** – working ahead of the age-related expected standard for this point in the academic year.

In addition to the above, should your child be working at a **Pre-Key Stage level**, this will be marked by the letters **PK** and a number e.g. **PK4**. This ranges from PK1 to PK4 for KS1 pupils and PK1 to PK6 for KS2 pupils.

At the end of your child's report there is a summary of any standardised assessments that they have undertaken so far. Please see the table below for a guide on each assessment type:

Accelerated Reader Age	Year 2 Year 3 Year 4 Year 5 Year 6	Reading	Accelerated Reader is a computer-based programme that allows the school to monitor and assess reading practice and progress. Children take short quizzes after reading books to check their understanding, as well as termly assessments to gauge reading levels. This assessment is reported in years and months. This assessment is compared against your child's chronological age.

White Rose Maths - Autumn	Year 1 Year 2 Year 3 Year 4 Year 5 Year 6	Mathematics	This assessment is in line with our mathematics curriculum that is taught at Beecroft Academy. The assessment comprises of an arithmetic and reasoning paper and is undertaken between Year 1 to 6. This assesses the curriculum coverage taught at the end of each term. 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Phonics Screening	Year 1 Year 2	Phonics	This check identifies the children who have learnt to decode using phonics. It is completed in KS1 and repeated each year until the child achieves the desired pass mark.																												

The table above shows the assessments that are undertaken by specific year groups during the Autumn Term. Please be aware that the above assessments are repeated throughout the year and some are only completed by specific children and year groups. Therefore, these assessments may not all be on the interim report that you receive for each term.

In addition to the Interim Report you receive today, please also find the National Curriculum expectations for your child's year group in the form of a leaflet. This can also be found on the school website. Please find this via the '**Learning**' and then '**Classes**' tab. It is important to remember that these expectations are for a child at the end of the year group that they are in and that all children learn and progress at different rates with their learning. All teachers carefully craft the curriculum to adapt for all children within their classes.
