Welcome to my newsletter. This week it has been wonderful to see the children enjoying PE lessons, playtimes and lunchtimes outside in the warmer and, more importantly, drier weather.

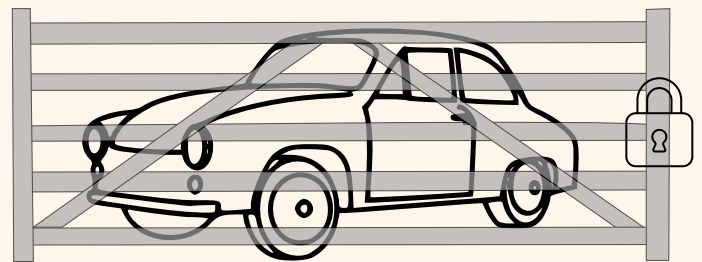
