Early Years Whipsnade Zoo Trip

Dear Parents and Carers

We have organised a trip to Whipsnade Zoo on **Wednesday 24th June 2026**. The visit will give the children an opportunity to explore different animals and their habitats.

The Beecroft Academy PTA has generously provided funding for the zoo tickets for all children, therefore the cost of the trip will be **£10.85** which covers the cost of transport. If your child is in receipt of pupil premium funding the cost of the trip will be **£9.77**. Places should be booked and paid for online at Magicbooking. By making your payment through Magicbooking you are giving your permission for your child to attend this trip. All payments need to be made by **Wednesday 17th June**.

Beecroft Academy does not make any profit from school activities unless it is known to be a fundraising event and charges are based on all pupils contributing; however, if insufficient funds are generated, it is possible that the visit may have to be cancelled. If the cost of the activity is prohibitive, please speak to your child's class teacher.

If your child is entitled to free school meals or you would like to order a packed lunch from Aspens, please order this through Magicbooking whilst booking for your child to attend. Please ensure you are registered on Swiftkitchen as the cost of the lunch will then be charged to your Swiftkitchen account for payment. Lunches must also be ordered by **Wednesday 17th June**. If you wish to provide your own packed lunch for your child, it must be in a named bag - no sweets or fizzy drinks are allowed.

Your child must wear their school uniform, however comfortable footwear is advised. Please ensure your child is fully prepared for the weather on the day of the trip (e.g. bring a raincoat if wet weather is forecast or a sunhat and sun cream if the weather will be dry and sunny).
