Transition Days

Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach the end of this academic year, we wanted to share details with you of what transition days will look like this year at Beecroft Academy.

We value these days hugely as they enable our children to begin building relationships with their new class and any new adults working within the year group that they will be in from September. We have three transition sessions. These are as follows:

Thursday 25th June - 1:45pm to 3:15pm

On this afternoon, the children will find out which class they will be in and who their class teacher for the new academic year will be. They will spend a short period of time in their new classroom and begin completing activities designed for both children and adults to get to know each other. You will receive a class flyer from your child's new teacher on this day too. This will introduce your child's class teacher and enable you to find out more about them.

Tuesday 30th June - 9:15am to 3:15pm and Wednesday 1st July - 9:15am to 3:15pm

On both of the dates above, the children will enter and leave school at the normal time through their current classrooms. After registration, they will move to their new classroom where they will spend most of the day. They will complete activities that are designed to further build new relationships and prepare them for the curriculum they will start in September.

On **Wednesday 1st July**, we would like to welcome you to your child's new classroom for our annual **Meet the Teacher** session where you will be able to meet your child's new teacher. Your child's new teacher will run through the curriculum ahead for September and any key information that you need to know about. These sessions will begin in all classrooms at 3:45pm. Please collect your child as normal and proceed to the external door of your child's new class. This will be the door that they are dismissed from in September and the children will be shown where this is across the transition days. We understand that some families will have children in multiple classes across the school, please see the school website where updated presentations will be added or liaise with the class teacher to find out more about any information missed.

We understand that these days are different and a change to normal classroom routines. Staff across the school will be on hand to support all children. We ask for your support in talking to your children about transition in a positive manner and that any worries and/or anxieties are natural. There will be an additional letter that will follow for specific children identified by Miss Bell and class teachers. This will give information regarding additional support that we will put in place for their transition to their new class, year group and, in some cases, phase.
