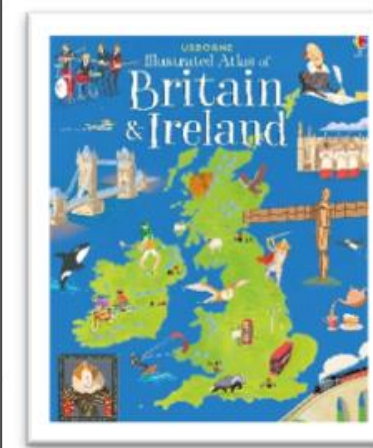

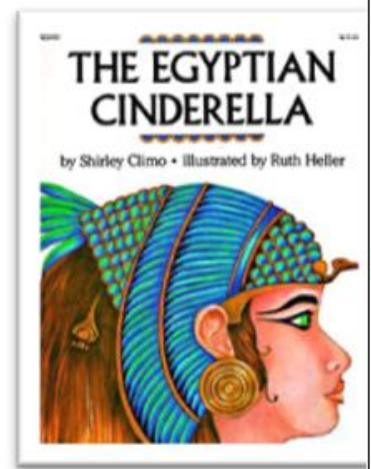

How can I help my child?

Reading	Writing
• Make reading an adventure - get them to act out scenes from books they've read. • Encourage a love of books through having a mini-library at home.. • Ask them for reviews of books that they've read and enjoyed.	• Consider analysing author's craft and model good reading habits. • Make writing a tool for communicating at home, such as starting a project or encouraging correspondence. • Focus on structure and vocabulary, including editing.
Mathematics	
• Develop their times table recall by using apps and games and visual aids. • Involve your child with practical problem solving, such as money, time or measure. • Use games to broaden their knowledge and encourage fun within maths.

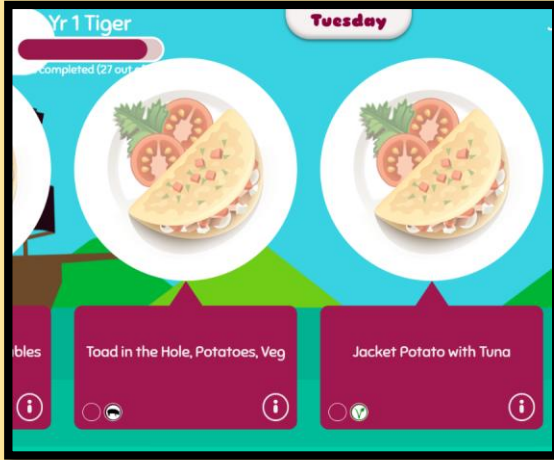


Items needed:
