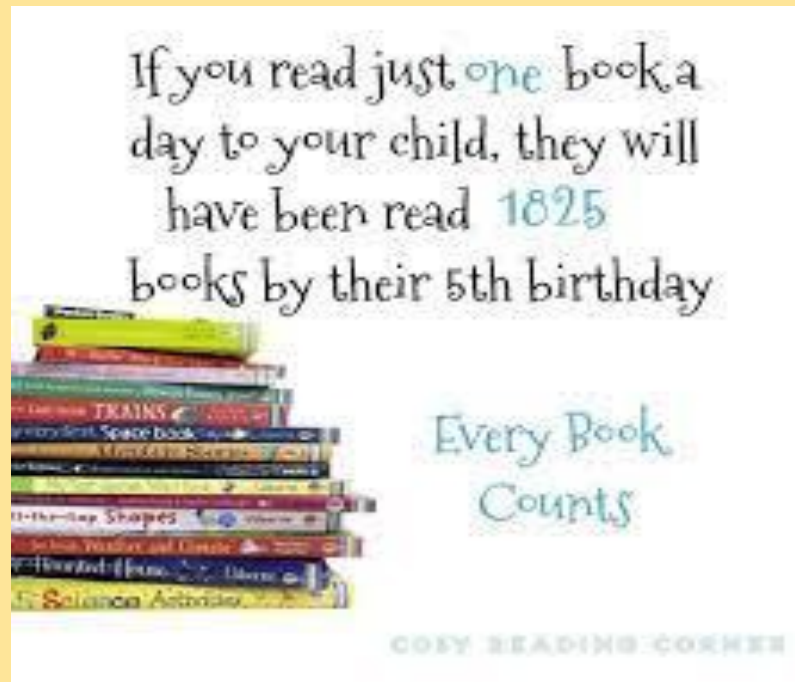
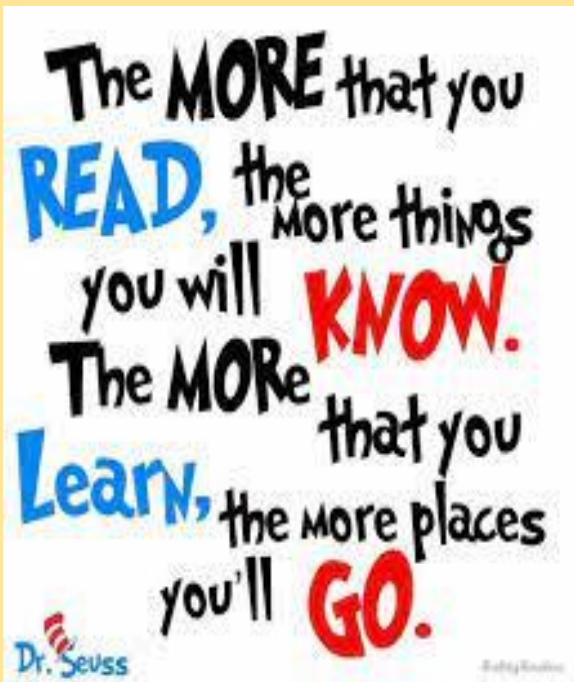
Things you can do to help

Create a picture showing different weathers and seasons. Write their names in French.	Use the internet to find out about the world's five oceans. Record your findings in a table and include information.	Go on a local walk and sketch or paint some of the wonderful wildlife or pretty flowers that you see.
Sketch a landscape using different shading techniques such as stippling, hatching and cross-hatching.	Use a range of sources to learn about rivers. Find out how rivers form, the three stages of a river, how rivers change the landscape and how people use them. Create a mind map to organise and record your findings.	What leisure and sporting activities do people do on rivers? Choose three of these activities and list the equipment required.
Create a poster about 'solids, liquids and gases', demonstrate your understanding by using water and the different processes that take place for water to alter state.	Find out what defines a mountain, how they form, different types of mountain and mountain habitats.	Create an exercise regime which can be used as a warm-up in a PE lesson. Then choose a game which the class can play.
Research some local creatures and create your own classification chart. Write your list of animals in alphabetical order.	Use the internet to find out about one of the world's rivers include information about the country and the animal life.	Make up a game which can be shared with the class. We will play it outside.
 Our topics this term are 'Misty Mountains, Winding Rivers'. We will be learning about rivers and mountains in different parts of the earth. In science, we will learn about 'solids, liquids and gases' as well as 'classification of animals'. We will look at different animals and learn how to draw them in proportion. You can choose and record whichever activity you would like. Tick the circle on the bottom right of each box to record the activities you complete.
