Label all school uniform, including PE kit.

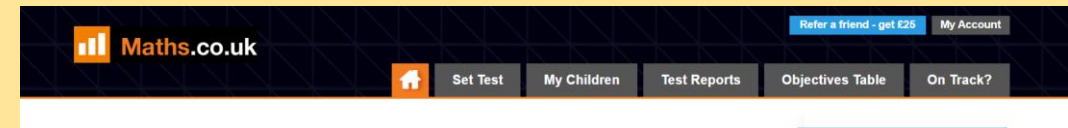
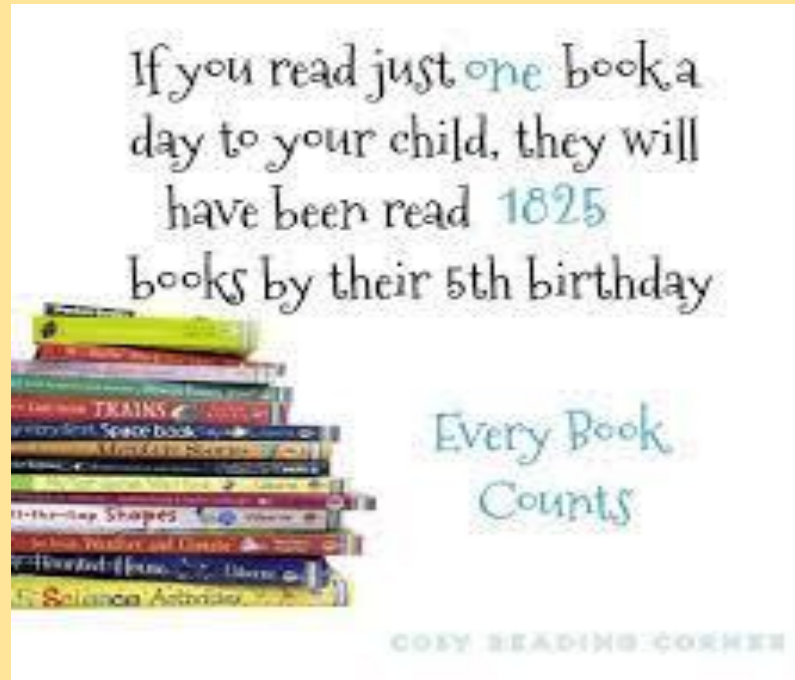
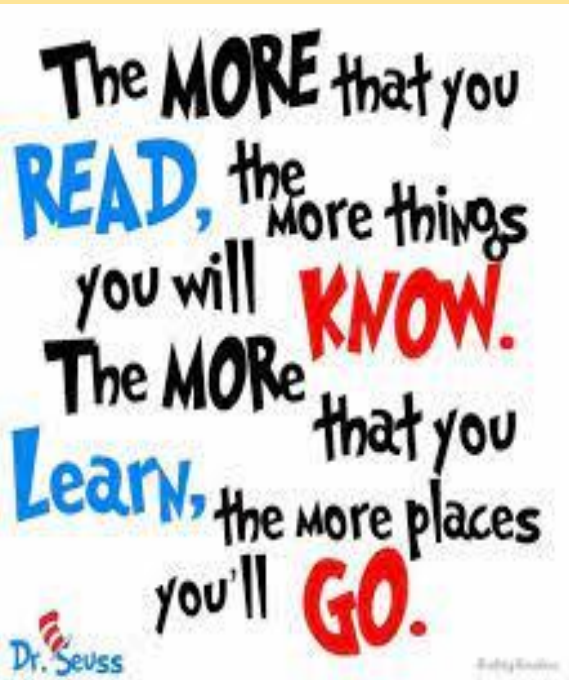
