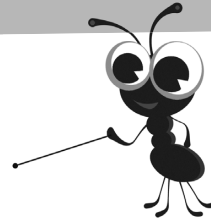

Problems page

Use multiplication facts from the 5 times table to find division facts



You will need:

- scissors
- glue

$1 \times 5 = 5$
$5 \times 1 = 5$

$6 \times 5 = 30$
$5 \times 6 = 30$

$9 \times 5 = 45$
$5 \times 9 = 45$

$12 \times 5 = 60$
$5 \times 12 = 60$

Teacher's notes

Children cut out division facts from the bottom of the sheet. They then match these to the patchwork quilt showing the related multiplication facts and glue them on.

$5 \div 5 = 1$	$45 \div 5 = 9$	$5 \div 1 = 5$	$30 \div 6 = 5$
$30 \div 5 = 6$	$60 \div 5 = 12$	$45 \div 9 = 5$	$60 \div 12 = 5$
