2, 5 and 10 multiplication

Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables

You will need:

- coloured pencils

Asif has 2 cats. Each cat has 5 kittens. How many kittens are in Asif's house now?

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Shanaz buys 4 badges. Each badge costs 10p. How much does she spend?

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Charlie bakes 8 cakes. Each cake has 2 sweets on top. How many sweets are there altogether?

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Holly has 11 pairs of toy dinosaurs. How many dinosaurs does Holly have altogether?

What to do

- Work with your child to answer the word problems, writing the calculations in the spaces provided.
- Remind your child that multiplication can be done in any order. Ask your child to work out each multiplication fact and then to colour pairs of answers that are the same.



Ask your child to choose five multiplication facts from above, and to write them down on the back of this sheet. Then next to each one, they write a related division calculation, e.g. $3 \times 2 = 6$ and $6 \div 2 = 3$.
