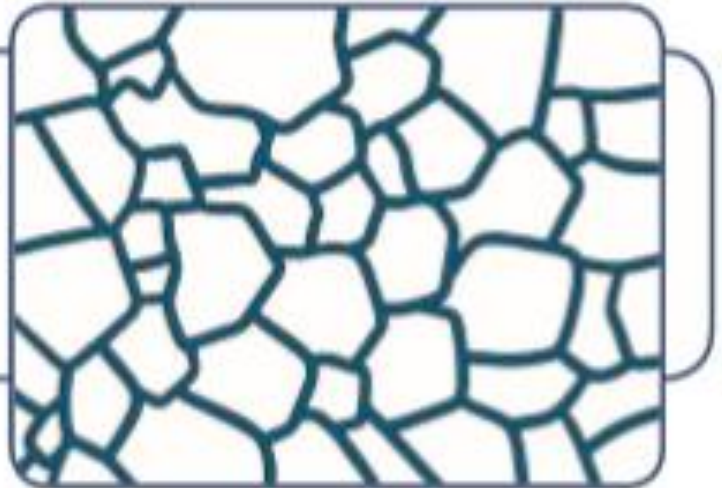


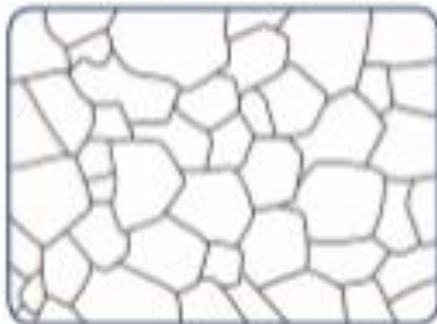
Antarctic Collage

You will need:

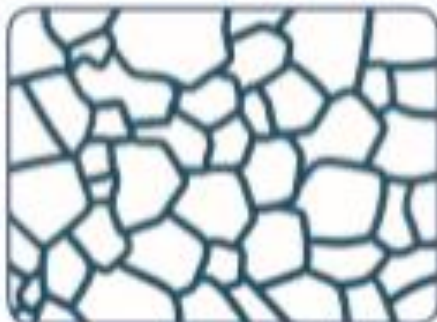
- A3 blue paper (1 page per child)
- A4 white paper (1 page per child)
- Scissors
- Glue sticks



1. Start with the A4 page of white paper.
2. Use scissors to cut the paper into irregular shapes, like this:



3. These shapes are now your pieces of ice.
4. Place the ice shapes over your blue paper (the sea).
5. Move your ice shapes apart so that there is space between them.
6. Stick your ice shapes in place over the sea, like this:



7. You could add Antarctic animals to your scene.

Create a penguin!

You will need;

- a tissue roll,
- black, white and orange paper
- Googly eyes (or draw them on)
- Scissors
- Glue



Steps:

1- First wrap your roll in black paper

2- Then cut out a white piece of paper into this shape  and stick onto the roll for the belly.

3- Stick 2 arms on either side of the body.

4- Next cut out a diamond shape for the beak using orange paper and stick on to create a face.

5- Use black and orange paper to create a feathery head, stick on top of the roll.

6- Cut penguin feet out and glue on.

7- Finally stick on your googly eyes, if you don't have googly eyes, draw them onto plain paper and stick them down.

Put your penguin onto your collage! Enjoy!
