

Didgeridoo

The **didgeridoo** is an Australian Aboriginal wind musical instrument. The longer the instrument, the lower the pitch or key of the instrument. They are a hollow wooden tube, which can be either cylindrical or conical in shape. It is best described as being a wooden trumpet.

Make Your Own Didgeridoo

You will have fun designing and then decorating your own didgeridoo in bright colours. The final touch is added with small sticky dots!



You will need:

- Long cardboard tube (Could be a long wrapping tube, or a few kitchen rolls put together)
- Poster paints in bright colours
- Coloured stick dots. (You can cut out round dots, colour them in and glue them down)

Instructions:

Paint your tube with the bright paint and leave to dry.

Decorate with the sticky dots.
